

McLean Citizens Association Resolution
MWAA Silver Line TPSS #2 Facility
Olney Road
November 24, 2010

Whereas, the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority (MWAA) received 2232 Review approval in 2007 to build a Traction Power Sub-Station (TPSS) in the VDOT right-of-way at the corner of Magarity Road and Olney Road; and,

Whereas, MWAA is seeking to modify the approved plan to utilize a 72' x 40' modular building to house the TPSS equipment and to lower the foundation 12 feet in order to reduce the visual impact on the adjacent Olney Road residents; and,

Whereas, the plan includes a drainage pond in the northwest corner to buffer the site's storm water; and,

Whereas, the Olney Park community, established in 1962, is a quiet neighborhood of 72 homes with a community park; and,

Whereas, the size and location of the drainage pond precludes the use of a berm and landscaping to further mitigate the visual impact of the structure;

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the McLean Citizens Association requests MWAA install an underground detention facility to buffer the site's storm water runoff.
